

## **AWARD LIST & PROJECT SUMMARIES**

In 2024 the California Jobs First Los Angeles Collaborative secured \$14 million in Catalyst Predevelopment Funding, with a **\$9M dedicated seed funding opportunity** to invest in predevelopment projects that drive innovation, growth, and community impact. The Catalyst review committee selected **26 proposals** that span across all industry sectors and Service Planning Areas (SPAs) in Los Angeles. A 10member Review Committee, composed of LA Collaborative members without conflicts of interest, convened to review, score, and recommend awards. The community-led subcommittee made the final recommendations. Awardees and project summaries are listed below.
